LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

1. APPLICATION OF TARIFF

1.1. GENERAL

This Tariff applies to the furnishing of Comcast Digital Phone service, as defined herein, by Comcast Phone of Connecticut, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Company"). Comcast Digital Phone service is furnished for the use of end users in placing and/or receiving local telephone calls within a local calling area or in placing Intrastate calls within the state of Connecticut. Services, features, and functions will be provided where facilities, including but not limited to billing and technical capabilities, are available.

The provision of local telephone service is subject to existing regulations and terms and conditions specified in this Tariff and the Company's other tariffs and service guides, and may be revised, added to, or supplemented by superseding issues.

In addition to the regulations and charges herein, this Tariff is subject to specific regulations as may be prescribed by the Connecticut Department of Public Utility Control.

1.2. TARIFF REVISION SYMBOLS

Revisions to this Tariff are coded through the use of symbols. These symbols appear in the right hand margin of the page. The symbols and their meanings are as follows:

(C) - To signify changed regulation or rate

(D) - To signify deleted material

(M) - To signify material moved to or from another section of the tariff with no change in text or regulation

(N) - To signify new material

(T) - To signify a change in text but no change in rate or regulation

1.3. DEFINITIONS

Broadband Local Service

Broadband Local Service provides the customer with an access line and usage within a local calling area for the transmission of two-way interactive switched voice or data communications.

Company

Whenever used in this Tariff, "Company", or "Comcast" refers to Comcast Phone of Connecticut, Inc., unless otherwise specified or clearly indicated by the context.

Customer

The person or legal entity that subscribes to service under this Tariff and is responsible for payment of charges for services furnished to the customer.

Customer Premises

The customer premises is all space in the same building occupied by a customer and all space occupied by the same customer in different buildings on contiguous property.

Facilities

Supplemental equipment, apparatus, wiring, cables and other materials and mechanisms necessary to or furnished in connection with communications service.

Local Calling Area

The area in which a customer of Local Exchange Service may complete calls without incurring long distance charges.

1.3. DEFINITIONS (CONT'D)

Local Access and Transport Area (LATA)

A geographic area established for the provision and administration of communications service. It encompasses one or more designated exchanges, which are grouped to serve common social, economic and other purposes.

Local Serving Area

The area in which the Company has the capability to provide local telephone service.

Long Distance Call

Any call extending beyond the exchange of the caller which is rated on a long distance schedule by a long distance provider.

"Public Utility Commission" or "D.P.U.C."

The Connecticut Department of Public Utility Control

Residential Service

Service is classified and charged for as Residential Service where the primary use of the service is of a domestic nature and where the business use, if any, is merely incidental.

User

A customer, or any other person authorized by a customer to use service provided under this Tariff.
