1.2 APPLICATION OF TARIFF

This Tariff sets forth the terms, conditions, rates and charges applicable to the services offered by Comcast Phone of Georgia, LLC, (d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone) hereinafter referred to as the "Company", in furnishing intrastate communications services within the State of Georgia.

1.3 TARIFF FORMAT

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1.3 TARIFF FORMAT (CONT'D)

1.3.3 RATE TABLES

Within rate tables, four types of entries are allowed:

- Rate Amount

The rate amount indicates the maximum dollar value associated with the rate or charge for service.

- A dash "-"

The dash indicates that there is no rate for the service or that a rate amount is not applicable under the specific column header.

- A footnote designator "[1]"

The footnote designator indicates that further information is contained in a footnote.

- ICB

The acronym "ICB" indicates that the product/service is rated on an individual case basis.

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1.4 EXPLANATION OF CHANGE SYMBOLS

The following symbols, notations and abbreviations shall be used in this Tariff for the purposes listed below:

SYMBOL	EXPLANATION
(C)	To signify change in regulation or Tariff
(D)	To signify discontinued rates, regulations, or text.
(I)	To signify an increase in rate.
(M)	To signify a move from one page to another with no change to text, regulation or Tariff.
(N)	To signify new rates and/or new regulation, and/or new text.
(R)	To signify a reduction in rate.
(T)	To signify change in text but no change in rate or regulation.

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1.6 SERVICE DESCRIPTION

Exchange Service, as offered in this Tariff, provides a Customer with the ability to connect to the Company's switching network which enables the Customer to:

- Place or receive calls to any calling station in the Customer's local calling area;
- Access basic Emergency 911 service;
- Access the interexchange carrier selected by the Customer for interLATA, intraLATA, interstate or international calling;
- Access operator services;
- Access directory assistance for the local calling area;
- Access telephone relay service;
- Place or receive calls to 800 telephone numbers.

1.6.1 SERVICE TERRITORY

The Company offers service within the State of Georgia, and concurs in the local calling areas and maps as filed by the incumbent Local Exchange Company.

Services, features, and functions will be provided where facilities, including but not limited to billing and technical capabilities, are available.
