5.0 EXCHANGE ACCESS SERVICE

5.1 GENERAL

5.1.1 SCOPE

- A. Exchange Access Service provides a Customer with a telephonic connection and a unique telephone number address on the public switched telecommunications network. Each Exchange Access Service enables users to:
1. receive calls from other stations on the public switched telecommunications network;
 2. access other services offered by the Company as set forth in this tariff;
 3. access (at no additional charge) the Company's business office for service related assistance;
 4. access (at no additional charge) emergency services by dialing 0- or 9-1-1; and
 5. access services provided by other common carriers which purchase the Company's Switched Access services as provided under the Company's Federal and/or State tariffs, or which maintain other types of traffic exchange arrangements with the Company.
- B. Each Exchange Access Service is available on a “Full” service basis, whereby service is delivered to a demarcation/connection block at the Customer's premise.

5.3 BASIC LINE SERVICE-RESIDENTIAL

5.3.1 DESCRIPTION

A. Basic Line Service-Residential provides a Customer with a single, voice-grade telephonic communications channel which can be used to place or receive one call at a time. Basic Lines are provided for connection of Customer-provided single station sets or facsimile machines to the public switched telecommunications network. Each Basic Line is provided with the following standard features which can be deleted at the Customer's option:

1. Call Waiting
2. ID Masking
3. Touch Tone

B. Customers who subscribed to Basic Line Service-Residential and who elected unlisted telephone number service prior to July 1, 1997, will receive unlisted telephone number service at no charge for so long as they maintain Basic Line Service-Residential.

5.3.2 RATES

Non-recurring and monthly recurring rates per Basic Line apply as follows:

Each additional line must be at the same address and billed to the same name as the first line.

5.4 BASIC LINE SERVICE-BUSINESS

5.4.1 DESCRIPTION

- A. Basic Line Service-Business provides a Customer with a single, voice-grade telephonic communications channel which can be used to place or receive one call at a time. Basic Lines are provided for connection of Customer-provided single station sets to the public switched telecommunications network. Each Basic Line is provided with the following standard features which can be deleted at the Customer's option:
1. Call Waiting
 2. ID Masking
 3. Unlisted Telephone Number
 4. Touch Tone

5.6 UNFEATURED ACCESS LINE-BUSINESS

5.6.1 DESCRIPTION

- A. Unfeatured Access Line-Business provides a Customer with a single, voice-grade telephonic communications channel which can be used to place or receive one call at a time. Unfeatured access lines are provided for connection of a Customer-provided facsimile machine, key system, or private branch exchange ("PBX") to the public switched telecommunications network

5.6.2 RATES

- A. For use with facsimile service or to connect key system with Company switch
