Question 3: Name the minority organizations, organizations for women, media, educational institutions, and other recruitment sources used to attract minority and female applicants whenever job vacancies become available.

Unit # 5589 works with a broad spectrum of recruitment sources to broadly distribute its job vacancy information and attract female and minority applicants.

With regard to its existing employees, Comcast posts notifications of its job openings on its employee intranet. In addition, an employee may set up a 'Job Agent' that will allow the employee to specify jobs they are interested in based on certain criteria or keywords. When a job is posted meeting the desired criteria an email is sent to the employee at regular intervals.

With regard to external candidates, Comcast attracts minority and female applicants and achieves broad outreach when filling its full-time vacancies by using both direct recruitment implemented by its recruiters and through its engagement of JWT Inside ("JWT"), an employee relationship marketing agency that integrates recruitment advertising, branding, strategy and internal communications to help organizations advance employee engagement.

JWT administers a system called "Easy Post," which interfaces with Comcast's E-recruiting tool. When a Comcast recruiter enters a new job requisition into E-Recruiting, the recruitment sources he or she selects to use via the Easy Post system are transmitted to JWT, which then posts the position with the selected sources. JWT tracks the posting start and end dates for each recruitment source, which is retained by Comcast's E-Recruit system for reporting purposes.

The recruitment sources administered by JWT include both internet job banks (e.g., Monster.com, CareerBuilder.com) and non-internet sources.

All jobs posted through JWT's Easy Post are automatically sent to the below websites, which include sources that are specifically directed to minority and female applicant pools, as well as veterans and individuals with disabilities:

Question 5: Describe the employment unit's efforts to encourage entrepreneurs to conduct business in a nondiscriminatory manner with all parts of its operation and provide an analysis of the results of those efforts.

At Comcast, the principals of diversity and inclusion aren't just about what happens inside our company. They guide with whom we work and how we work with them. Our supplier diversity program offers every business, regardless of ownership or size, an opportunity to compete for business within our company. It is designed to promote, increase and improve the participation of small and diverse-owned businesses in our supply chain. It provides Comcast purchasers with reliable resources, creates jobs, strengthens our purchasing power, and builds value for our shareholders.

To qualify as a Comcast or NBCUniversal diverse supplier/vendor, a company must be one of the following:

- Minority Businesses Enterprise (MBE)
- Women Businesses Enterprise (WBE)
- Veteran Businesses Enterprise (VBE)
- Service Disabled Veteran Businesses Enterprise (SDVBE)
- Small Disadvantaged Businesses Enterprise
- Historically Underutilized Business Enterprise (Hub Zone)

Outreach to and partnership with diverse organizations is a key success factor for our Supplier Diversity program. Throughout the year, we actively target outreach events and build partnerships with various advocacy organizations across our geographic footprint, participating in numerous conferences, awards ceremonies, capacity-building events, and business opportunity fairs at the local, regional, and national levels. Each year, we participate in 50-60 supplier diversity targeted outreach events across the country designed to create connections between diverse suppliers and corporations.

Comcast and NBCUniversal partner with minority-led chambers of commerce and other diverse business organizations throughout the country at the national, regional, and local levels. Our supplier diversity partners include:

- National Minority Supplier Development Council (NMSDC)
- Woman's Business Enterprise National Council (WBENC)
- National Veteran-Owned Business Association (NaVOBA)
- US Hispanic Chamber of Commerce (USHCC)
- US Pan Asian American Chamber of Commerce (USPAACC)
- The National Center for American Indian Enterprise Development (NCAIED)
- National Black Chamber of Commerce (NBCC)
- National Gay and Lesbian Chamber of Commerce (NGLCC)
- Walter Kaitz Foundation

In addition, Comcast and NBCUniversal are active with each of these organizations and many of their local affiliates across the country.

Comcast believes strongly in providing equal access and opportunity to all vendors. Comcast's supplier diversity program effectively provides special assistance to small and multicultural business owners in their pursuit of business opportunities. In addition, Comcast and NBCUniversal participate on boards and in programs that assist with growth of diverse business enterprises.

We also believe that encouraging prime (Tier I) vendors to subcontract with diverse second-tier (Tier II) vendors can expand our business with diverse vendors while reducing barriers to entry for those businesses. To that end, we partner with its non-diverse prime contractors to identify methods by which they will include a diverse supplier base through subcontracting. Comcast strongly encourages joint ventures, prime/Minority, Women and Disabled Veteran-owned Business Enterprises partnerships, and subcontracting as methods to create additional business opportunities for diversity owned vendors.

Supplier diversity is an important component of our Request for Proposal (RFP) and vendor selection process. Comcast's standard RFP language encourages Tier II diversity, and Comcast considers Tier II diversity among its criteria for purchasing decisions. NBCUniversal has added Tier II reporting to all new contracts and requests for proposals. This reporting requirement will also be added to older contracts after they expire and are renegotiated.

We have also taken steps to further our goal of increasing the number of prime suppliers who provide Tier II data by encouraging Tier I vendors to work with the company to help expand the Supplier Diversity Program through the successful creation of Tier II opportunities for diverse businesses.

The Company also has taken proactive steps to work with diverse suppliers in underutilized categories and we are expanding procurement opportunities for professional services firms. Examples include:

- Legal: Comcast and NBCUniversal actively seek to do business with diverse law firms. In 2010, Comcast became a founding member of the Inclusion Initiative, a collaborative effort of several companies designed to increase the utilization of diverse law firms. Comcast and NBCUniversal have increased spending with diverse law firms, and in 2011 the combined company spent more than \$1.6 million with them. In addition, Comcast and NBCUniversal's legal teams are focused on expanding the amount of business done with minority and female lawyers at majority-owned firms.
 - o In 2011, Comcast participated in National Association of Minority and Women-Owned Law Firms (NAMWOLF) and Inclusion Initiative conferences and business opportunity fairs. In addition, Comcast continues to participate in other conferences and events which support the minority bar.
 - o The Company has also directed its insurance company to utilize diverse law firms, when available, in cases that pertain to Comcast worker's compensation and liability claims.

- Financial: Comcast's history of involvement with the minority-owned banking community spans more than 20 years and continues today. We value our relationships with minority-owned banks and investment firms that offer differentiated and tailored solutions designed to address the company's needs, including lending through credit facilities, brokerage services for stock repurchases, bond underwriting, and commercial paper issuance, as well as traditional banking and deposit arrangements. For example:
 - o For the 9th consecutive year in 2012, Comcast arranged a major credit facility with ten minority-owned banks, including our administrative and syndication agent, United Bank of Philadelphia. This is a \$24 million 364-Day Revolving Credit Facility.
 - o Minority-owned banks have participated in the underwriting of numerous Comcast bond offerings, adding value to the process and earning significant income along the way.
 - o Comcast uses several diverse banks to execute open market repurchases under the company's Board-authorized Stock Repurchase Program.
 - o In 2011, Comcast added a minority-owned bank as one of its four placement agents in our commercial paper program.
- Marketing: Together, Comcast and NBCUniversal increased spending on advertising with minority-owned media 2011 by \$7 million, primarily with African American-owned media. Grupo Gallegos is Comcast's primary advertising agency for Hispanic-targeted creative. In 2011, Comcast also selected Burrell Communications, as our agency of record for African American consumer market advertising.

In addition to the initiatives listed above, the results of our Supplier Diversity program are reflected, in part, by the recognition it has received. Examples include:

- In August 2012, Comcast was named one of the Best Companies for Asian American and Pacific Islanders by Asian Enterprise magazine, which recognized Comcast's "unwavering and continued commitment to the small business community" and "invaluable contribution to the Asian American and Pacific Islander community."
- For the seventh consecutive year in 2012, Comcast received recognition for being one
 of the Top 50 Organizations for Multicultural Business Opportunities by
 DiversityBusiness.com.
- For the sixth consecutive year in 2012, Comcast was named among the 10 Best U.S. Corporations for Veteran-Owned Business by NaVOBA.
- The Rocky Mountain Minority Supplier Development Council named Comcast its Corporate Partner of the Year in July 2012.
- Comcast was recognized as the National Black Chamber of Commerce's Corporate Partner of the Year in August 2011.
- Black Enterprise magazine selected Comcast as one of its 40 Best Companies for Diversity in 2012, recognizing supplier diversity among Comcast's strengths.
- In 2011, Comcast's "excellent supplier diversity program" was recognized by DiversityInc., which ranked Comcast among its 25 Noteworthy Companies

Comcast believes these efforts have been successful in encouraging entrepreneurs to conduct business in a nondiscriminatory manner with all parts of its operation.

Question 7: Describe the responsibility of each level of the employment unit's management with respect to application and enforcement of its EEO policy and explain the procedure for review and control of managerial and supervisory performance.

Comcast's Corporate Human Resources Department has ultimate responsibility for the implementation and enforcement of its EEO practices. The Corporate Human Resources Department communicates with the HR Leads for each Division to ensure that Comcast's EEO policies are understood and applied at all levels of the company's operations.

The Division and cable system managers have primary responsibility for the implementation of Comcast's EEO policies on the local level of each FCC employment unit. Each of Comcast's Divisions conduct an independent analysis and review of HR practices on the cable system level on a periodic basis to ensure that Comcast's EEO policies are being correctly implemented and enforced.

Comcast managers, department heads, and supervisors are all responsible for ensuring that all employment and promotion decisions made within their employment units are consistent with the company's EEO policies and are free of discrimination. All such managerial and supervisory personnel receive training on the Comcast Code of Conduct. The responsibilities of these individuals include, but are not limited to:

- Working with Comcast's Human Resources Department to understand the individualized EEO-related goals for their employment units and implementing an EEO plan in order to achieve those goals;
- Performing periodic audits of training, hiring, and promotion activities to ensure compliance with the company's EEO program and achievement of EEO goals, and to notify the Human Resources Department of any problems encountered in implementing the program;
- Ensuring employee awareness of the company's EEO policies through training programs that familiarize employees with the program and its goals;
- Ensuring that minority and female employees have the opportunities for transfer and promotion based on their experience and skills;
- Counseling employees in their employment units regarding career opportunities;
- Performing periodic audits of employment units to ensure that: (I) EEO notifications are properly displayed; (II) minority and female employees are encouraged to participate in all company-sponsored educational, training, recreational, and social activities; and
- Ensuring that the employment units' work environment is discrimination free by prohibiting and vigorously enforcing the prohibition against racial slurs or remarks, sexual harassment or any behavior which is actually or apparently discriminatory or intimidating to employees.

Comcast's Human Resources Department has primary responsibility for producing and verifying each employment unit's EEO Public File Report on an annual basis and ensuring that the report is placed in the unit's public inspection file and on Comcast's website. In addition, whenever there is a vacancy, a member of the local Human Resources Team reviews the job

description to ensure accuracy and works closely with Comcast's Hiring Managers on selection techniques to find the best candidate for a job opening in a consistent and non-discriminatory manner. Local Human Resources Teams also review any counseling or disciplinary actions taken, including potential terminations to ensure consistency within the unit. Potential terminations are also reviewed by the Regional Vice President of Human Resources to ensure consistency within the Region. Depending on the circumstances, potential terminations may also be reviewed by the Division Vice President of Human Resources.

All Comcast supervisors attend periodic training and workshops to review the EEO laws and the company's commitment to being an EEO employer. Comcast also provides training on maintaining a harassment-free workplace to all front-line and management employees every other year.

Successful implementation of Comcast's EEO policies and procedures is reviewed as part of the performance appraisal of each Comcast manager, supervisor, and corporate employee with EEO responsibilities.
